Use

Visiting the library as well as consultation at the information desks is free of cost.

A library card is required for borrowing media or making use of available electronics.

With a library card, one can borrow a maximum of 50 media from any Dortmund library.

Media can only be returned in the library from which they were borrowed.

Lending periods can be extended online, over the phone, by email or in person up to two times per media as long as no more than 10 Euros in charges have been accrued.

28 days: books, periodicals, sheet music,

maps, games, DVD box sets, tool

lending library

14 days: bestsellers, CD-ROMs,

educational films on DVD, CDs, console games, tool lending library

7 days: DVDs

Costs

Library cards as well as borrowing bestsellers and console games are with cost. Additional fees are charged for excededing lending periods (overdue media) and reservations. Media that is damaged or lost must be replaced.
